

IN THE BERKSHIRES **HOPKINS MEMORIAL FOREST**

NW Hill Rd. Williamstown, MA 01267

The Hopkins Memorial Forest (HMF) is a 2600 acre (1040 ha) reserve in Massachusetts, New York and Vermont managed by the Williams College Center for Environmental Studies (CES) to facilitate research and undergraduate teaching activities while preserving and monitoring forest resources, particularly through long-term ecological research. We strongly encourage disciplinary and interdisciplinary teaching, scholarly activity, and experimental research in the Forest.

NATURAL BRIDGE STATE PARK McAuley Rd, North Adams, MA 01247

Natural Bridge State Park is a Massachusetts state park located in the city of North Adams in the northwestern part of the state. Named for its natural bridge of white marble, unique in North America, the park also offers woodland walks with views of a dam made of white marble, and a picturesque old marble quarry.

CLARKSBURG STATE PARK

Clarksburg State Park is a 368-acre (149 ha) Massachusetts state park located in the town of Clarksburg. The park is made up of unspoiled Greylock and the Green Mountains.[2] It is managed by the Department of Conservation and Recreation.

Taconic Trail State Park is located on Mohawk Trail (MA-2). This hotspot is unique in that it has both early successional forests, pollinator gardens, and with a short hike you can be within a mature forest. The diversity of habitats makes it good for birding and wildlife viewing in any season.

Explore this 2.2-mile out-and-back trail near North Adams, Massachusetts. Generally considered an easy route, it takes an average of 55 min to complete. This is a very popular area for birding, hiking, and running, so you'll likely encounter other people while exploring. The trail is open year-round and is beautiful to visit anytime. Dogs are welcome, but must be on a leash.
